What type of information we have

We collect information via our mailing list sign-up form hosted on EmailOctopus, our Slack workspace through opting to join-up, through our Eventbrite events, and via email if you contact us directly.

Information collected includes:

- Your name;
- Your email address.

How do we get the information and why we do we have it?

The personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following purposes:

- You have used our mailing list sign-up form to join our mailing list or receive an invite to join our Slack workspace.
- You have contacted us directly via email to request to be added to our mailing list.
- You have registered to attend one of our events listed on Eventbrite.
- You have contacted via email us to make an information request.

We only hold the information necessary to respond to your enquiry and process your requests, including your name, email address and any written text describing your needs.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information is:

- Your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting our Data Protection Officer, Fiona MacNeill.

What we do with the information we have

We use the information that you have given us in order to:

- Respond to your enquiry via email;
- Send you information about Ladies that UX Brighton via email;

- Send you an invite to join our Slack workspace;
- Send a reminder to attend an event for which you have registered at Eventbrite.

How we store your information

Our Mailing List and Newsletter

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access – You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification – You have the right to ask us to rectify information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure – You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing – You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing – You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability – You have the right to ask that we transfer the information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
